Incredible Accomplishment in Open Water Swimming

Shubham aspired to swim in the world's most difficult to cross waters
where many have invested their tons of energy and funds of their
personal fortune. No challenges broke Shubham's determination. He
accomplished what the people of his age would only dream of!

The ruthless freezing water & waves of The English Channel

In 2014, Shubham successfully crossed the cold English Channel from Dover (England) to Calais (France) the distance of 31 km distance in 12 hours and 42 minutes despite brutal weather conditions of 10 to 12 degrees water temperature and 6-meter-high waves.

The record-break swim in The Strait of Gibraltar

Shubham broke the 15 years old Asian record by crossing the Strait of Gibraltar, swimming from Tariffa, Spain to Morocco, Southern Africa covering the distance of 18 kilometers in only 3 hours and 16 minutes.

With that Shubham became the fastest Swimmer in Asia who crossed the Strait of Gibraltar.

He was also the youngest male swimmer in the world during the year 2014. It is also record in LIMCA BOOK OF RECORDS.

Catalina Channel swim in the Pacific

Swum successfully Catalina Channel 31 km swim from Santa Catalina Island to San Pedro Shore in Los Angeles[California], US in 10 hours, 42 minutes and 6 seconds on 25th August 2015.





Manhattan Island Marathon New York

Shubham also swum Manhattan Island Marathon (50 KM) in 8hrs 10 mins on 11 September 2015 at New York, USA.

Shubham achieved a big feat in India as well!

In 2014 he swam from Dharamtar to Gateway of India near the coasts of Mumbai, a distance of 35 kilometers in 8 hours.

He showed that endurance despite warm weather conditions of the Arabian Sea.
